**Places where Jews were murdered in the village of Doibani**

**Type of site:** Place of murder

**Briefly describe the significance of the site:**

On September 3, 1941 a lorry with the retaliatory group came from Dubasari. Having arrived in the village, the commandant ordered the local major to bring the communists, the leaders of the village and the Jewish people. On arrival of all the required people they have been surrounded with the armed soldiers from the retaliatory group and they had been driven to the place of execution at the edge of the village where an anti-tank ditch had been dug. After execution the people from the village buried the corpses.

**The site designated as:** historic site

**Size of site:** 3 X 5 m.

**Deliberate changes to the site since the Holocaust:**

After war the remains of the shot people were reburied.

**Any monuments or other signs on / near the area of the object:**

On the place of execution the monument with the list of the shot people in 1941 had been installed. And at the distance of 100 meters the monument to the soldiers-liberators of the village Doibani had been established.

**Address of the site:** the crossroads of the villages Doibani 1 and Doibani 2

**Date of establishment:** During the 70<sup>th</sup> years

**Financing the works for monument:**

The village authorities financed installation of the monument
