The Kishinev Old People's Home

There was an old people's home at the Hospital officially registered under the name of "Big Kishinev Jewish Almshouse". The Almshouse was located in two brick buildings; in one and a half- store building, there lived men (30 persons), while another one- store building was for women (also 30 persons). In the ground floor of the first building there was a warehouse. The old people received in the Almshouse free of charge meals, clothes and medical help. The Almshouse was kept at the expense of the charity "Society for Taking Care of the Poor Jews Both Men and Women".
