**Building of the former synagogue,  
the present Hesed Hana in Tiraspol**

**What was in the building:** Before the war in the building there was a synagogue.

**Address of the building:** Tiraspol, Kotovsky street 14

**Amount of floors:** 2

**The owner of the property rights before 1939:** the Synagogue

**The present owner of the property rights:** Hesed Hana

**At the moment the building is used:**  
By the Welfare Culture Jewish Center Hesed Hana

**Deliberate changes of the building:**  
Inside the building the lay-out had been completely changed.

**Brief history of the building:**  
Before the war in the building there was the synagogue, then the building was used for dwelling. 8 families lived in the building. There were no any simple living conditions. In 1995 the city authorities returned the building to the Jewish Community. Due to the support of JDC the overhaul had been made, and in 2001 with support of the Pozner's foundation in the yard of the existing building the Day Center was constructed.

**Condition of the building today:**  
The building is in a good condition. In December 2003 - January 2004 a cosmetic repair was done.
