The Holocaust Memorial in the village Tsybulevka

Type of object: the burial place

Brief history:

The fascists to Dubossari have dragooned a part of the Jewish population, 10 persons, where they were shot. In Tsybulevka Tsipra Arbit and her daughter Rosa Borisovna were shot. Her second daughter, Ita Borisovna, had an awful fate. The gendarmes and '*politsais*' had bound her to the horsetail and the horse was running in the field until Ita, tortured, died.

On the memorial the names of the villagers who died at the front and the local Jews who died by the fascists's hand are written.

In the village school, which is not far from the memorial, there is a museum. The museum is dedicated to the memory of the War veterans, participants of this area clearing, and the victims of fascism.

The place is:

A historical object

A sight

The size of the object: 15 X 15 m.

Peculiarities of the Holocaust period:

During the war on that place there was an uncared park with a ditch

Address of the object: Village Tsybulevka, on the riverbank, opposite to the village school.

Date of establishment: ≈ 1980.

Financing of works on the monument:

Local authorities, the council of the village

Inscriptions on the monument:

« ETERNAL MEMORY, UNDYING GLORY AND ETERNAL REST TO
YOU WHO STOOD AND HAVE WON »
